We can offer the right candidates a friendly, challenging yet supportive working atmosphere and a committed team of colleagues who are keen to develop skills and services.

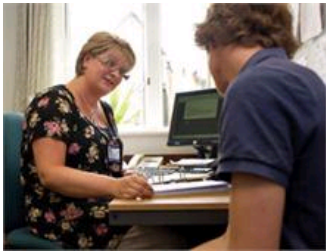

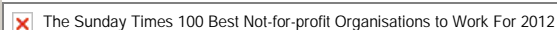
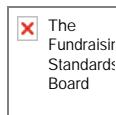
